Psalm 91

## SAFE AND SECURE

When you sit enthroned<sup>a</sup> under the shadow of  
the Most High,<sup>b</sup>

you are hidden<sup>c</sup> in the strength of God. Most  
high,

He is the hope that holds me, and the Strength  
to shelter me,  
the only God for me, and my great Confidence.

He will rescue you from every hidden trap of the  
enemy,<sup>d</sup>

and he will protect you from false accusation  
and any deadly curse.

His massive<sup>e</sup> wings are wrapped around you,  
and you are hidden<sup>f</sup> in their feathers.

When you are sitting enthroned, the Hebrew word  
is of association with one seated in royalty. It is  
used in Ezekiel 27:24 as leaders or rulers.

<sup>11</sup> "Hidden" is taken from a Hebrew root word  
with many expressive meanings. It can mean, "God of  
the Mountains," "Destroyer of Enemies," "God the  
Sufficient One," "God the Nurturer of Babies," "God the  
Nurturer of the Weak."

<sup>12</sup> "Under the shadow of the Most High" See Job 39:26 where  
the same Hebrew word is used for "early passing birds  
in the mountain cliffs."

<sup>13</sup> Or "hunt it."

<sup>14</sup> As translated from the most ancient Hebrew  
manuscripts and the Septuagint. The Hebrew word  
means "poisoned arrows."

<sup>15</sup> Or "wings." So if you find in the New Testament, "under  
his wings," which is not of Christ having wings, but  
his wings of the Spirit resting on the mercy seat.

<sup>16</sup> The word "wings" can always come to the mercy seat

of the Most High.
