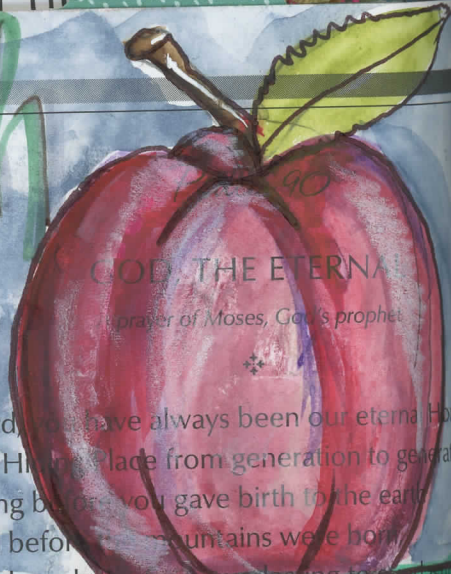


# Teach me
